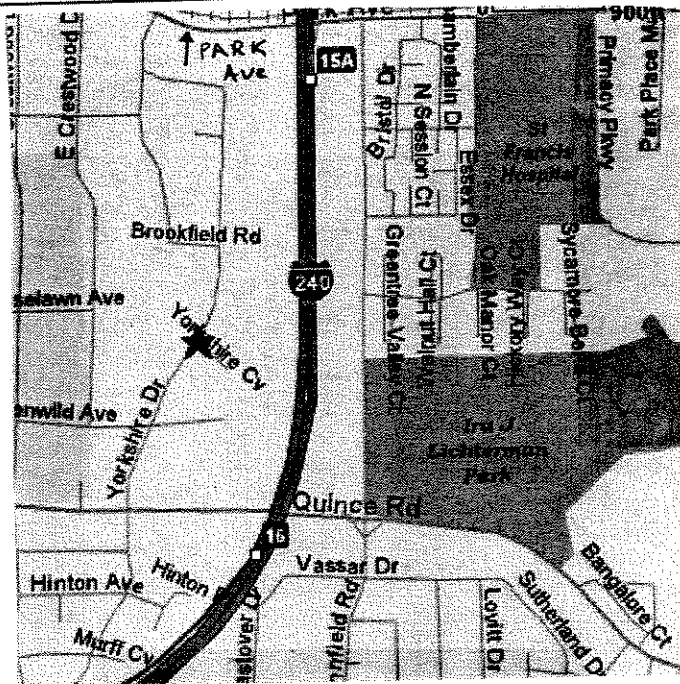
*Hospitality to ND Alum Seeking Shelter From Hurricane Ivan*
